
Oxford Mathematics Public Lectures Roger Penrose and Jon Chapman



M.C. Escher Artist, Mathematician, Man

The symbiosis between mathematics and art is personified by the relationship between Roger Penrose and the great Dutch graphic artist M.C. Escher. In this lecture Roger will give a personal perspective on Escher's work and his own relationship with the artist while Jon Chapman will demonstrate the mathematical imagination inherent in the work.

The lecture will be preceded by a showing of the BBC film 'Secret Knowledge: The Art of The Impossible: M.C. Escher and Me' presented by Sir Roger Penrose. Private Escher prints and artefacts will be on display outside the lecture theatre.
