Public Sector Equality Duty (PSED)

Aim: to ensure that public bodies always consider the needs of all individuals.

Protected characteristics:

- Age
- Disability
- Gender reassignment
- Pregnancy and maternity
- Race this includes ethnic or national origins. Colour or nationality
- Religion or belief this includes lack of belief
- Sex
- Sexual orientation
- Marriage and civil partnership for first point overleaf only

Public bodies are required to have due regard* to the need to:

- eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment, victimisation and any other conduct prohibited under the equality legislation;
- advance equality of opportunity between people who share a protected characteristic and people who do not share it;
- foster good relations between people who share a protected characteristic and people who do not share it.

*due regard = consciously think about these three aims as part of the decisionmaking process
