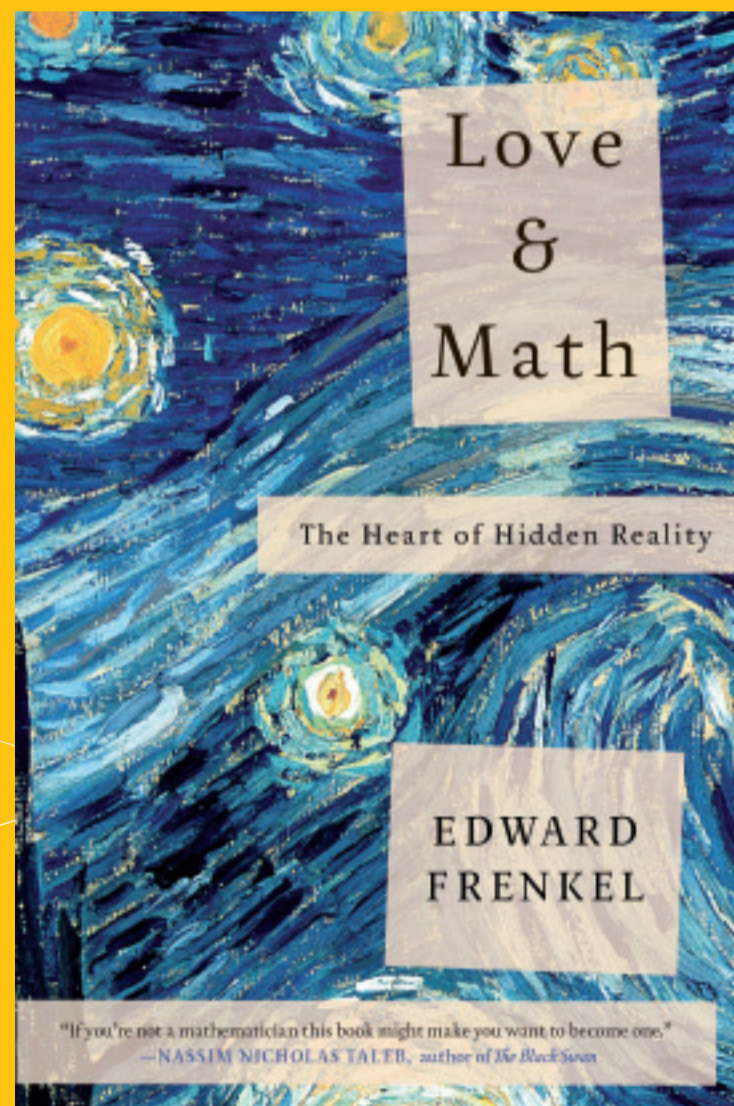
“Love and Math”
