

Train to teach at Future Academies with the **Future Teach Scholarship**

- A bursary of up to £30,000
- Tuition fees up to the value of £9,250
- Guaranteed placement at one of our academies in and around London

Future Academies is a multi-academy trust, consisting of three primary academies and seven secondary academies. We are a family of schools characterised by our emphasis on raising student aspirations and outcomes through the provision of a knowledge-rich curriculum. We have an outstanding School-Centred Initial Teacher Training (SCITT) programme (Future Teacher Training), which recruits and trains the next generation of high-calibre teachers.

The SCITT provides trainees with classroom-based teacher training and mentoring at one of our academies, as well as weekly-centralised professional studies, delivered by a range of experts in the educational field. Our trainees also undertake a PGCE with our university partner to extend their suite of qualifications and gain Masters Credits for their studies. Ofsted has rated Future Teacher Training 'Outstanding', in recognition of the high-quality provision we offer, and as a result of our excellent outcomes. In addition, we have been ranked the best such provider in London and the third best in the country by the most recent Good Teacher Training Guide.

We are currently recruiting highly motivated graduates to apply for our Future Teach Scholarship, an additional bursary for outstanding graduates. Successful candidates to the scholarship are eligible for funding worth up to £30,000 during their first year of training with us. We will also cover their full tuition fees, up to the value of £9,250.

We are particularly on the lookout for individuals who display passionate and detailed subject knowledge, who have a strong academic record, and who have a passion for education and for passing their knowledge onto the next generation. Since we piloted the scholarship route in 2016, we have recruited 14 graduates from Oxford, whose subject expertise and passion we highly value.

For the academic year 2022-2023, we are recruiting undergraduates and postgraduates in all subjects, including English, Maths, Sciences, Geography History, and MfL.

How to Apply

To apply, applicants first submit an application to gov.uk platform 'Apply'. They can find a list of our courses on our website (www.scitt.futureacademiesorg): once they have identified the appropriate one, they can then enter the course code and Centre code on the Apply application form. Once this form has been submitted electronically, they should send a CV and covering letter to our Head of ITT, Natalie Parker (enquiries@scitt.futureacademies.org), stating that they are applying for the Future Teach Scholarship, and providing details of the subject or phase (primary or secondary) that they are interested in.

Interviews for the scholarship take place on a rolling-basis, after the applicant has successfully interviewed for a place on our SCITT. Once the SCITT offer is confirmed, an application will be considered for the Future Teach Scholarship. The process includes a rigorous panel interview with both our sponsors and with senior representatives of Future Academies, alongside aptitude and writing tests.

These scholarships are very competitive, and we are therefore looking for unique candidates who possess exceptional subject knowledge and will go on to make a life-changing difference to our students.
